Function Reference/get post

Description

Takes a post ID and returns the database record for that post. You can specify, by means of the `$output` parameter, how you would like the results returned.

Usage

```
<?php
get_post($id, $output);
?>
```

Example

To get the title for a post with ID 7:

```
<?php
$post_id_7 = get_post(7);
$title = $post_id_7->post_title;
?>
```

Alternatively, specify the `$output` parameter:

```
<?php
$post_id_7 = get_post(7, ARRAY_A);
$title = $post_id_7['post_title'];
?>
```

Parameters

`$post`

(*integer*) The ID of the post you'd like to fetch.

`$output`

(*one of OBJECT, ARRAY_A, ARRAY_N*) How you'd like the result. OBJECT = as an object, ARRAY_A = as an associative array of field names to values and ARRAY_N = a scalar array of field values.
