Function Reference/timer stop

Description

This function returns the amount of time (in seconds) to generate the page.

Usage

```
<?php timer_stop($display = 0, $precision = 3) ?>
```

Example

Usage

Determine length of time to render page with a precision of 3, 5 and 10 digits.

```
<?php echo('Seconds: ' . timer_stop(1) . '<br />'); ?>  
<?php echo('Seconds: ' . timer_stop(1,5) . '<br />'); ?>  
<?php echo('Seconds: ' . timer_stop(1,10) . '<br />'); ?>
```

```
Seconds: 0.815  
Seconds: 0.81551  
Seconds: 0.8155429363
```

Parameters

display

(*integer*) Possible values: 0 or 1. Defaults to 0.

precision

(*integer*) Possible values: 0 or 1. Defaults to 3.
