Template Tags/get calendar

Description

Displays the calendar for the last month with any posts in it. This tag can be used anywhere within a template.

Usage

```
<?php get_calendar(daylength); ?>
```

Examples

Default Usage

Displays calendar for the last month highlighting any dates with posts.

```
<?php get_calendar(); ?>
```

Displays Weekday Abbreviations

Display days using first two letters of each day name; in 1.5, displays abbreviation based on your WordPress [Localization](#).

```
<?php get_calendar(2); ?>
```

Parameters

daylength

(*integer*) The length of the abbreviations for the days of the week. Defaults to 1 representing the first initial of weekday. For example:

- 1 causes "Sunday" to be displayed as "S"
- 2 causes it to be "Su"

Note: Starting with 1.5, any value other than 1 will display abbreviation based on your WordPress [Localization](#).
